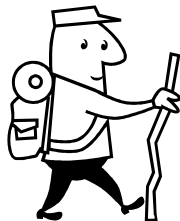

India is a country that possesses a unique alchemy of various races, religions, cultures, traditions and rituals.

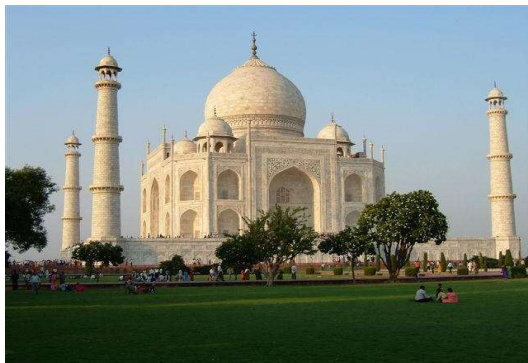


NEERA MALLICK is going to talk to us about her country with information about festivals, monuments, people and culture.

We can only visit this factory during working hours, so put yourselves in a good mood for the weekend with this stimulating tour!

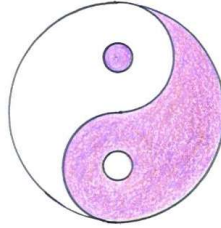
