Dr. Jenny (a director of Brown Boveri), a member of the Baden Museum Committee, is an authority on these famous windows.


WINETASTING AT THE WUERENLINGEN WALDHUETTE

To find the Waldhütte follow the route marked on the map below.





SATTEL-Hochstuckli




